

It was very funny and provided insight into how to overcome the challenges associated with cross-cultural appointments. I think our church is already doing a good job.

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> tsp. almond extract 1 pt. vanilla ice cream

Ann Yelle 1-1/2 c. sliced fresh peaches whipped cream chopped nuts

Checking account reconciled with bank statement. Internal account balances are Checking \$168.27; Elevator Repair \$524.00; Local Disaster \$390.00; New Ministries \$2019.80; Christmas Walk \$8500.00; Scholarships/ Youth Awards \$260.00; Sunday School \$925.18 for balance of \$12,787,25. Other accounts: Building/Restoration \$1969.04; Youth Fellowship Account \$4243.73.

Julie reported she used \$2500.00 from the Christmas Walk fund to cover April bills.

We received a \$24.07 Amazon Smile donation.

Current checkbook balance is \$745.20 with \$4717.13 in known bills for the month of May.
