Cranberry Fruit Nut Bread

2 c. flour

1 c. sugar

1 1/2 tsp. baking powder

1 tsp. salt

1/2 tsp. baking soda

1/2 c. chopped nuts

2 T. shortening

1 T. grated orange peel

1 egg, well beaten

1 1/2 c. cranberries,

coarsely chopped

3/4 c. orange juice

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease 5x9-inch loaf pan. Mix together flour, sugar, baking powder, salt and baking soda. Stir in orange juice, shortening, orange peel and egg. Mix until well blended. Stir in cranberries and nuts; spread evenly in loaf pan. Bake for 55 minutes, or until toothpick inserted in the middle comes out clean. Cool on rack for 15 minutes. Remove from pan; cool completely. Very good!
