Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we approach the blessed season of Christmas, we are reminded of the profound truth expressed in C.S. Lewis's book, "Miracles". In it, Lewis writes:

"The central miracle asserted by Christians is the Incarnation. They say that God became Man. Every other miracle prepares for this, or exhibits this, or results from this. It was the central event in the history of the Earth—the very thing that the whole story has been about."

This idea calls us to reflect deeply on what we celebrate at Christmas. The miracle of the Incarnation is not just for those who already know Christ, but for the whole world, for every soul longing for meaning, hope, and love.

This Christmas, let us embody this message in our own lives. As we gather with family and friends, as we worship and give thanks, let us remember to share this light with those who feel forgotten, lonely, or estranged from God. The Incarnation assures us that no one is beyond the reach of God's love.

May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ fill your hearts with joy this Christmas and may His light shine through you to a world in need.










FOOD PANTRY SUNDAY DECEMBER 29
